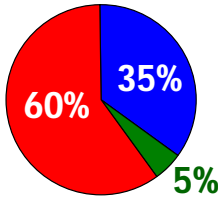


Age-Adjusted Death Rates for Illinois, 2002 - 2006

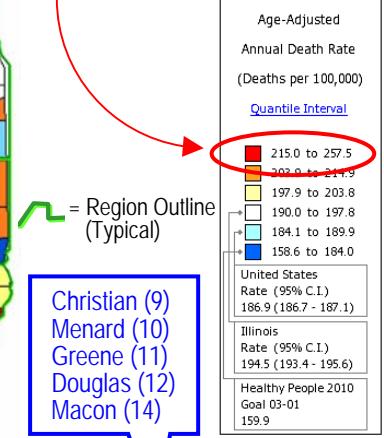
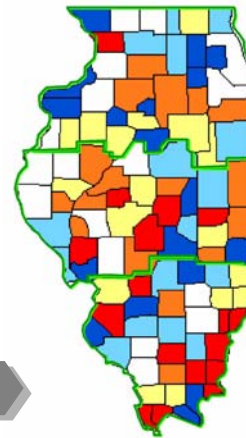

Highest All-Cancers Death Rates by Region

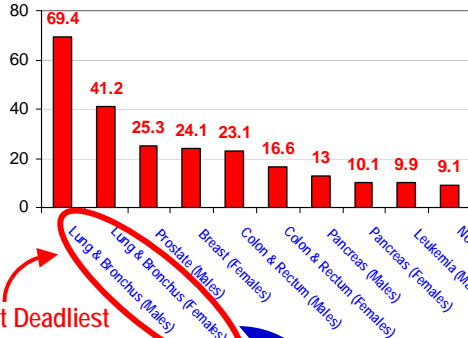


Illinois Counties with All-Cancers Death Rates in Highest Quantile Interval (17 Red Color Counties on Map)



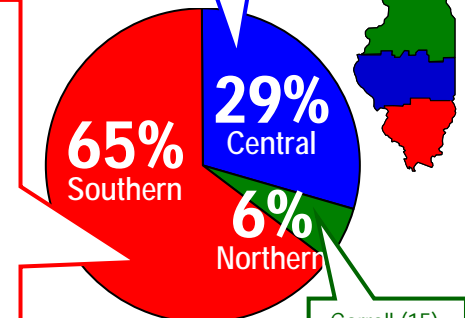

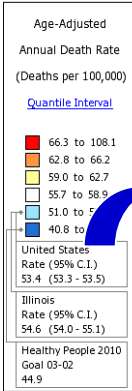

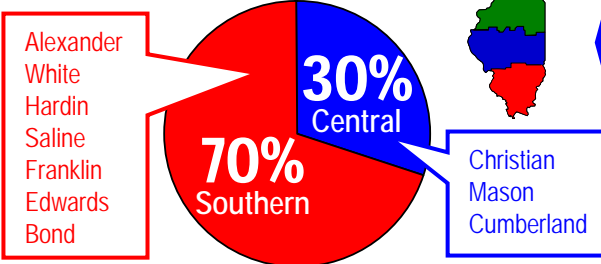
Age-Adjusted Death Rates for Illinois, 2002 - 2006
